Chemical burning

What happened?

An operator left a bucket with a strong alkaline cleaning agent unattended on the cleaning platform instead of putting it in the available spill box. During the movement of a hose laying on the platform, the bucket capsized and the alkaline product dropped down in the neck and on the face of a cleaning operator working below the platform. Proper action of his colleagues avoided worse injuries!



What was the cause?

A dangerous product was left unattended on the cleaning platform in an open packaging. Instructions to put it in the available spill box were not followed.

How can this be avoided?

Never store dangerous goods unattended in open buckets. Use a spill box, closed pails, bins or drums labelled with appropriate warnings or dispose used product immediately in a safe manner! Keep platforms decently at all times! Check regularly the proper functioning of the emergency devices. They help to prevent major injuries!
